

RESTORATION OF OPERATOR'S HOUSE AND STORAGE ROOMS PIERS 6 & 7 SOUTH SIDE

1.0 GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The work under these items shall consist of the architectural restoration of the Storage Rooms, Flag Decks, and Operator's House located on the south side of Piers 6 & 7. Restoration shall include:

- 1. Demolition of all indicated components including, but not limited to: windows and doors, roofing materials, interior finishes, flagpoles and attachments, drainage systems.
- 2. Cleaning, repointing of all masonry, and the realignment of all dislocated masonry components from the top of the parapet wall to the top of the granite coping just above water level and as indicated on the drawings.
- 3. Provision and installation of new building components including but not limited to: windows and doors, roofing systems, lighting systems, drainage systems, flagpoles, roof scuttles.
- 4. Cleaning, restoration, repatination, and reinstallation of two existing bronze flagpole bases including the recasting of missing elements. This Work shall be executed in accordance with Code 900.9904 ORNAMENTAL BRONZE METALWORK. The payment for this Work shall be included under Code 900.9901.
- 5. Provision and installation of ornamental bronze window grilles, including those located on the granite screen walls on north face of Piers 6 & 7. This Work shall be executed in accordance with Code 900.9904 ORNAMENTAL BRONZE METALWORK. The payment for this Work shall be included under Code 900.9901.
- 6. Cleaning, restoration, repatination, and reinstallation of four existing bronze plaques located at the east and west termini of the Washington Pedestrian Bridge and Bridge No. 700.

All work shall be performed in accordance with the phased sequence of construction.

<u>Note</u>: The Contractor shall inspect the specified areas for repair to acquaint themselves with the location, kind and extent of the work to be performed before submitting the proposal.
