

ADDENDUM NO. 01
Request for Qualifications No. 23-13

Prospective Proposers and all concerned are hereby notified of the following changes/comments related to the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) document, RFQ No. 23-13. These changes/comments shall be incorporated in and shall become an integral part of the RFP.

Below are questions posed by Prospective Proposers along with RITBA's response:

1. The contract requires that a payment and performance bond be provided. Please confirm that RITBA will provide compensation for the bond. **The selected contractor will be required to provide a payment and performance bond and will be compensated for the bond.**
2. Can the authority advise if the scope of work is intended to be completed this year. **Yes, the intent is to complete the required work this year.**
3. RITBA is proposing to compensate the contractor on a time and materials basis. With no established ongoing contract with RITBA there is no existing budget to absorb the costs of an onsite superintendent and their vehicle. Please advise if RITBA will provide hourly compensation for an onsite superintendent and their vehicle. This accommodation has been made in the past by RITBA under similar circumstances. **Yes, Superintendent labor and vehicle will be covered through reporting on daily logs signed off on by the Contactor and Resident Engineer.**
4. RITBA is proposing to compensate the contractor on a time and material basis. If the work crew reports to work and inclement weather limits or prevents work from occurring, please confirm that RITBA will pay the union workers for the hours that we are obligated to per our collective bargained union agreements (i.e., show up time for journeymen and guaranteed 8 hours a day for foremen). **Yes, union workers will be compensated for reporting time in compliance with any collective bargaining union agreements.**
5. RITBA is proposing to compensate the contractor on a time and material basis. If work for a particular week includes a holiday, or there are related holiday lane closure restrictions or limitations, please confirm that RITBA will pay the union foremen for the hours that we are obligated to per our collective bargained union agreements (i.e., 8 hours payment for holiday). **RITBA will compensate holiday pay in compliance with any collective bargaining union agreements.**
6. Will a project schedule and schedule updates be required? **Yes, a simple bar chart schedule of work to support RITBA scheduling of Resident Engineering coverage and MPT is required by the Contractor. Updates to the schedule will be required by the contractor to identify any changed needs for inspection and MPT support. The RIDOT specified loaded schedule requirements do not apply.**
7. RITBA is requesting that a Labor & Equipment Rate schedule be submitted. Is there a list of specific equipment that RITBA could provide, or should we just provide a general list of company owned equipment? **The requirement for labor and equipment rate schedules will not apply to this RFQ. The RIDOT Force Account Specifications will be utilized to support documentation and payment.**
8. RITBA is requesting that a Labor & Equipment Rate schedule be submitted. RIDOT Specifications for Force Account work state that payment for labor will be based on the rate of wage actually paid as shown by its certified payroll and the equipment rates will be based on the Rental Rate Blue Book or rental invoices. Will the contractor provided Labor & Equipment Rate schedule or the RIDOT Specifications be used as the basis for payment? **The requirement for labor and equipment rate schedules will not apply to this RFQ. The RIDOT Force Account Specifications will be utilized to support documentation and payment.**
