1. PRE-BID SIGN-IN SHEET

ITEM 1-1: Meeting was held via Zoom without a sign-in sheet.

2. QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q1: Does the City of Pawtucket have a contractor in place that does the actual sidewalk and tree plantings work?

A1: Yes, the City has two separate contractors that do the work for these programs. However, the contract for the sidewalk work is being renewed in May of this year.

Q2: The RFP states the consultant will transmit formal cost estimates to applicants via mail and e-mail. Can you clarify this process – what is the timeframe for the City providing the mailing list, does the consultant receive and coordinate responses, etc.

A1: The consultant will provide all documentation, including formal cost estimates to the owner (City of Pawtucket) and not the applicant.
