- 1. What is the timeline of install for these items?
 - A. Equipment is needed as soon as possible and should be delivered and installed as pieces arrive. It is anticipated that all pieces will be delivered and installed by early May. The winning bidder will coordinate with Mike McCullough in Dining Services as pieces arrive to schedule delivery and installation.
- 2. What does the delivery site look like? Are there any stairs, dock, etc.?
 - A. Delivery is to a loading dock with an elevator
- 3. Please describe the access to the site. Is this something that can be accomplished with just two delivery men? Are there stairs or elevators that would necessitate additional staff?
 - A. Delivery is to the 2nd floor from loading dock. Elevator and stairs available.
- 4. Please identify the equipment that is to be removed and disposed of. Is the university responsible for any disconnections of old equipment?
 - A. The equipment in the bid is replacing identical equipment in the facility. The existing equipment will be used up to the day that the replacement equipment is installed. The winning bidder will need to disconnect the existing equipment, which may include plumbing and/or electrical shutdowns to completely remove the existing and set the new equipment in place.
- 5. Please advise the expected time frame for delivery.
 - A. See answer to #1 above.
- 6. Will you require a local sales person do a usage demonstration once installed and functional?
 - A. No
- 7. Do you need copies of installation manuals for your utilities trades people?
 - A. Yes. Normal instruction manuals are expected.
